Hello,

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) is interested in knowing the operational status of your marina as a result of Sandy. Please briefly answer the following items:

1. Facility Name & Address
2. Does your facility store, use, or sell oil (i.e. lubricating oil, gasoline, diesel, etc.)?
3. Were any damages sustained to your oil operations?
4. Has a spill of oil occurred from your facility? If yes, how much was spilled into waterways, and what measures were taken to mitigate the spill?
5. Are any oil tanks and/or drums missing as a result of Sandy?

The EPA will determine appropriate follow-up activities based on your response, or lack of response. The EPA strongly recommends that you reply to this request promptly at the following email address: [Region2\\_marinas@epa.gov](mailto:Region2_marinas@epa.gov)

The EPA will also answer any compliance questions or concerns you may have regarding oil storage and Spill Prevention, Control, & Countermeasure (SPCC).

As a reminder, please remember to report all spills of oil, including oil sheens, to the National Response Center at 1-800-424-8802 so that appropriate clean-up efforts can be coordinated.

Please feel free to forward this email to your marina counterparts whose operations include storing, handling, and/or selling oil (including diesel and gasoline).
